CONDITIONS

- To be eligible to receive a bursary or scholarship with UOW College, the applicant must be a citizen of an eligible country. Students who are citizens or permanent residents of Australia or New Zealand are not eligible for these bursaries or scholarships.
- Where a student extends their course after commencing at UOW College, the tuition fee for the period of the extension will be at the same bursary or scholarship rate.
- The bursary or scholarship must be taken up in the session in which it is offered. Students who are required to extend their English course will continue to be offered the bursary or scholarship provided they commence the UOW College Diploma or Foundation Studies course in the next available session. Where an applicant defers the course commencement date to a starting date, the scholarship may not be re-offered.
- This scholarship and bursary scheme supersedes all previous offers.
- Applications must be received one month prior to the commencement of the scheduled course start date (this may be waived at the discretion of UOW College).
- Students awarded bursaries and scholarships may be contacted by UOW College and asked to represent and promote the College in selected marketing activities.

Effective from **1st January 2017** for all offers issued for courses commencing in 2017 (until further notice).

Fees are shown in AUD. Fees are dependent on the actual year of commencement and are subject to change without notice and annual increases.
