GOVERNMENT HELP LOANS

*FEE-HELP is a loan from the Australian Government that helps eligible fee paying students enrolled in the University Entrance Certificate, Diploma of Business, Diploma of Information Technology, Diploma of Social Science and the University Access Program pay their tuition fees. Students can choose to pay tuition fees upfront or by instalment, pay a proportion upfront and use FEE-HELP for the remainder, or use FEE-HELP to cover the full tuition fee (up to the student's lifetime FEE-HELP limit).

^VET Student Loans is an Australian Government income contingent loan scheme that assists eligible students enrolled in approved Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses at approved training providers pay their tuition fees, subject to a maximum loan amount. VET Student Loans will only be approved for students who meet eligibility requirements. A VET Student Loan gives rise to a HELP debt that continues to be a debt due to the Commonwealth until it is repaid.
