





TAILORED TO YOUR NEEDS

Every English Plus Alpha Study Program is tailored to meet individual group goals, needs and language proficiency. Typically, programs run for 1-6 weeks with 4 hours of English lessons per day followed by an activities program of guest lectures, industry visits and excursions.

We believe this approach enables students to contextualise their outside experiences and provide grammatical and functional structures for the oral English they are experiencing.

We recommend group sizes of 15+ participants.



ENGLISH PLUS SOCIAL WELFARE PROGRAM

Our Social Welfare course explores important social issues in communities including disability, youth and the disadvantaged.

Students will have an opportunity to learn new concepts and theories along with hands-on experience through industry visits, classroom observations and specialist lectures. Opportunities to research and present their learning outcomes and compare social welfare systems between countries are provided at the conclusion of the course.

Important life skills and global minds are developed through the wide range of opportunities and experiences offered in our Study Tour Programs.

HOMESTAY

UOW College Australia Homestay allows students to live with a caring local family and be immersed in the Australian way of life.

UOW College Australia Homestay is the most popular accommodation option for study tour students. The Homestay program began more than 25 years ago and has diligently cared for many students and families over this time.

Our program is coordinated by UOW College Australia staff onsite. We have a dedicated homestay team that work very closely with over 250 local families ensuring our students are placed with kind and supportive families, who want to showcase Australia and the local Wollongong area.

Students and staff have a direct line of communication with our UOW College Australia Homestay team and a 24-hour emergency contact is available should the need arise.

UOW College Australia Homestay take great pride in the care of children as young as 10 years old to ensure they are safe and receive a higher level of care. Special services are provided by families hosting our under 18 Study Tours, such as daily transfers to and from campus and packed lunches.

In addition to UOW College Australia Homestay, the University of Wollongong offers a range of student accommodation. 66
