INTERNATIONAL BURSARIES AND SCHOLARSHIPS

ENGLISH PROGRAMS - BURSARY

Vietnam \$300 per week (normally \$510 per week)

50% SCHOLARSHIPS (MERIT BASED)

Students applying for a Diploma or Foundation Studies course will receive a 50% scholarship if they have the following GPA scores:

7.0 Elite Schools or 7.5 Other Schools in Year 12 (Diploma courses)

7.5 in Year 11 (Foundation Studies courses)

CONDITIONS

1. To be eligible to receive a bursary or scholarship with UOW College, the applicant must be a citizen of an eligible country. Students enrolling as citizens or permanent residents of Australia or New Zealand are not eligible for these bursaries or scholarships.
2. Where a student extends their course after commencing at UOW College, the tuition fee for the period of the extension will be at the same bursary or scholarship rate.
3. The bursary or scholarship must be taken up for the session in which it is offered. Where an applicant defers the course commencement date to a starting date after the expiry of the offer, the scholarship may not be re-offered.
4. This scholarship and bursary scheme supersedes all previous offers.
5. Applications must be received one month prior to the commencement of the student's intended start session (this may be waived at the discretion of UOW College).
6. Students awarded bursaries and scholarships may be contacted by UOW College and asked to represent and promote the College in selected marketing activity.

Effective from **1st October 2017** for all offers issued for courses commencing in 2018 (until further notice). Fees are shown in AUD. Fees are dependent on the actual year of commencement and are subject to change without notice and annual increases.
