SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND ADMINISTRATION

- a. The UOW College Australia Indigenous Scholarship ('the Scholarship') is sponsored by UOW College Australia.
- b. The Scholarship is awarded to the Scholarship recipient for the selected UOW College Australia program, as identified in the Scholarship Offer.
- c. The Scholarship is awarded to the value of the standard tuition fee only, as applicable at the time of course commencement, for the UOW College Australia program, as identified in the Scholarship Offer.
- d. Scholarship applicants who are eligible for a NSW Government Smart and Skilled funded full fee exemption will be required to access this funding in lieu of a UOW College Australia Indigenous Scholarship. Only UOW College Australia Vocational programs are approved courses for NSW Government Smart and Skilled funding.
- e. All UOW College Australia courses are eligible for the Scholarship.
- f. The Scholarship is applicable at all UOW campuses where UOW College Australia courses are offered.
- g. The Scholarship monies will be applied directly to the Scholarship recipient's UOW College Australia account by UOW College Australia as tuition fees become due and payable. The Scholarship is not redeemable for cash. No Scholarship amount, in any form, will be issued to the Scholarship recipient directly, nor will the Scholarship recipient be eligible for a refund of, or other access to, any unused Scholarship amount. Any unused Scholarship amount will be retained by UOW College Australia and is not transferable to another UOW College Australia or UOW course or other cost that may be incurred at UOW College Australia or UOW or to any other person.
- h. The Scholarship does not cover any additional tuition fees associated with course extensions beyond the standard course duration due to repeat study or failure to meet progression requirements or withdrawal from any subjects or units of competency after census day, unless otherwise determined by the UOW College Australia General Manager. Any additional tuition fees payable will be borne by the Scholarship recipient. A range of payment options are available – please refer to the UOW College Australia website for details.
- i. The Scholarship does not cover any other associated study costs that may apply, including but not limited to, text books, photocopying, parking/transport costs, administration charges, accommodation and costs associated with work placement, etc.
- j. Scholarship recipients may study either a full time or part time study load and can apply to amend their study load at any time, noting census day implications and notification obligations outlined below.
- k. Tuition fee liability is imposed from census day for UOW College Australia Academic and Vocational programs. The Scholarship amount for each study period will be deemed expended when a Scholarship recipient's enrolment is beyond the published census day for that study period. Withdrawal from a subject or unit of competency after census day will consume the apportioned Scholarship amount for the subject or unit of competency in that study period unless extenuating circumstances apply. A determination on whether extenuating circumstances apply will be made by the UOW College Australia General Manager or delegate based on documentary evidence provided by the Scholarship recipient. of competency on or prior to census day will not consume the apportioned Scholarship amount for the subject or unit of competency in that study period.

2. GENERAL OBLIGATIONS

- a. I understand that if I wish to make any changes to my enrolment after I accept this Scholarship, I must notify a UOW College Australia Student Advisor and seek approval. The Student Advisor will ensure any implications in relation to the Scholarship or my studies are outlined to me and, if applicable, will complete and submit the relevant documentation to facilitate my request.
- b. I understand that the Scholarship offer only applies to the course and associated commencement date identified in the Scholarship Offer and cannot be transferred to another course or deferred to another session or year unless extenuating circumstances apply. I understand that it is my responsibility to submit documentary evidence to the UOW College Australia General Manager or delegate for a determination on whether extenuating circumstances apply and that my case will be considered on its own merits. If it is determined that extenuating circumstances do not apply, I understand that if I wish to defer my course to another session or year or apply for, or transfer to, another course, I must apply for a new Scholarship. If a new Scholarship is awarded, I understand that I will be required to review and accept new Scholarship terms and conditions for the Scholarship to come into effect.
- c. I understand that a Scholarship recipient cannot receive any other scholarship or sponsorship from any other organisation that is intended to cover the cost of the tuition fee for the course identified in the Scholarship Offer, or part thereof, and declare that that I am not in receipt of any other such scholarship or sponsorship.
- d. I understand that I must maintain my enrolment in the course identified in the Scholarship Offer for the Scholarship to remain in effect and that my entitlement to the Scholarship will cease if I withdraw from the said course.
- e. I understand that in addition to the terms and conditions outlined in this document, I am obliged to comply with all rules, regulations and policies of UOW College Australia and the University of Wollongong, and any conditions of offer.
- f. I understand that a Personal Support Plan may, at the discretion of the scholarship committee, be implemented from course commencement to foster successful academic outcomes. I agree to discharge the support activities outlined in the Personal Support Plan for the duration of my enrolment for which I am in receipt of the Scholarship and understand that any failure to comply with the Personal Support Plan will be managed by UOW College Australia as misconduct. I understand that I can discuss and amend my Personal Support Plan with the Course Progress Advisor in accordance with my support needs at any time. I understand that the Personal Support Plan implemented can also be amended by the Course Progress Advisor in accordance with the Student Progression and Support Policy if I fail to meet course progression requirements or am identified as at-risk of not meeting progression requirements.

- g. I understand that I must accept these terms and conditions prior to course commencement and that if I fail to do so, the Scholarship Offer will be voided and I will be liable for the course tuition fees.

3. TERMINATION

- a. I understand that failure to meet any of the terms and conditions outlined in this document may result in the Scholarship being terminated.
- b. I understand that the Scholarship may be terminated if, following the award of this Scholarship, UOW College Australia obtains additional information about my academic background which would require a re-assessment of my application for admission and application for the Scholarship.
- c. I understand that the Scholarship will be terminated if, following the award of the Scholarship, it is determined that the Scholarship Offer was made on the basis of incorrect, incomplete or fraudulent information supplied by the applicant.
