#### INTERNATIONAL CAMPUSES


Beyond Australia, UOW has campuses in Dubai, Hong Kong, Malaysia and a presence in China and Singapore.

#### **University Excellence Scholarship**

30% tuition fee waiver for any undergraduate degree, includes honours degrees commencing the year following completion, \*excluding Doctor of Medicine, Nutrition and Dietetics, Exercise Science and Rehabilitation, Education, Social Work and Psychology.

### UOW Postgraduate Academic Excellence Scholarship

30% tuition fee waiver for master's (coursework) degree \*excluding Doctor of Medicine, Nutrition and Dietetics, Exercise Physiology, Teaching, Social Work and Psychology degrees.

#### **Country Bursaries**

10% tuition fee reduction on eligible courses for any undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree for students from all countries and regions.\*
