The English for Academic Purposes (EAP) and English for Tertiary Studies (ETS) courses are delivered over a specified number of weeks, designed to help students meet the English language requirements for their academic programs.

PACKAGED PATHWAYS

Foundation Studies and Diploma programs that can be packaged with UOW bachelor's degrees. Students receive a combined offer and CoE, and upon meeting progression requirements, transition into first or second year of their degree.

Scholarships

UOW College Australia offers a range of international scholarships for both English Language and Academic Pathway programs.

All applicants are automatically assessed for a scholarship during the application process. If successful, the scholarship will be included in the offer letter. Students may also be eligible for additional scholarships for the university component of a packaged offer.





HLT54121 DIPLOMA OF NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

A 10% tuition fee waiver is available for international students who are eligible for an offer to Study the HLT54121 Diploma of Nursing at UOW College in 2026.



ACADEMIC COURSE BURSARY

A 20% tuition fee waiver is available for the minimum duration of UOW College Academic Diploma or Foundation Studies course for all international students.*



ENGLISH LANGUAGE PATHWAY BURSARY

A 20% tuition fee waiver is available for students enrolled in English for Academic Purposes or English for Tertiary Studies, where these courses are a required component prior to commencing a UOWC Diploma or Foundation Studies program.

Students who receive this bursary are also eligible for the International Academic Course Bursary.*



ENGLISH LANGUAGE BURSARY

International students who are citizens of Central and South America, Japan, Korea, Taiwan, Thailand, Turkey, or Vietnam are eligible for a reduced English tuition fee of \$420 per week (normally \$599 per week).

This bursary applies to offers for English for Academic Purposes, English for Tertiary Studies, or General English courses*
